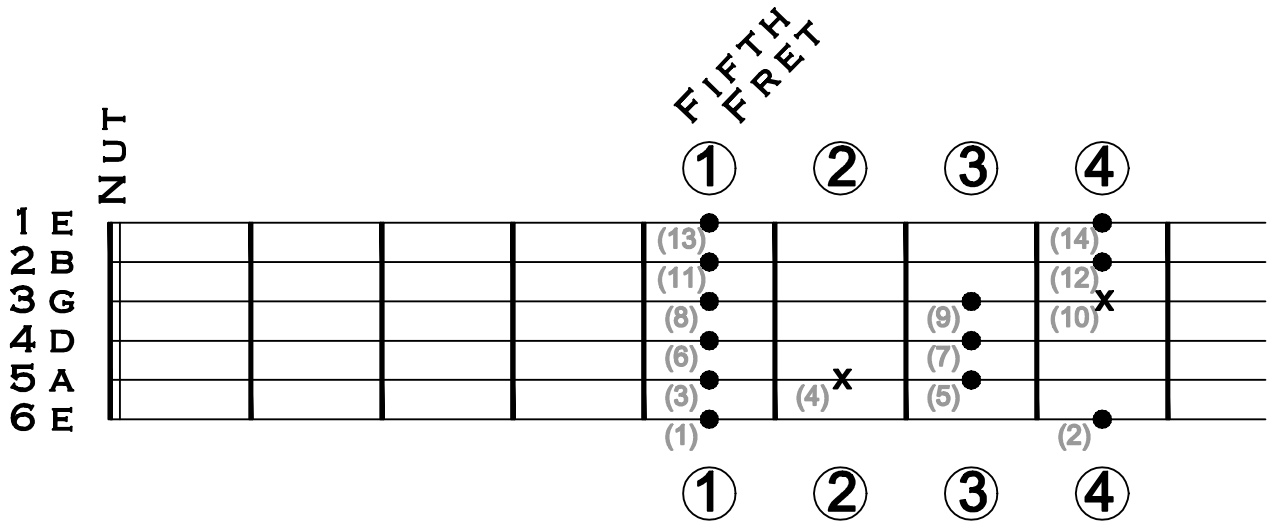


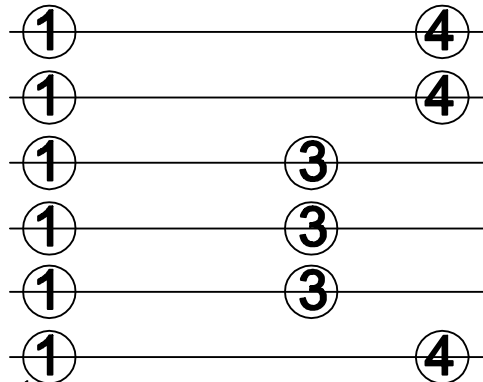
GUITAR SCALES



Two Octave Rock Scale (Pentatonic)

When playing scales, the hand does not move up or down the neck. You have four fingers which fret the notes of the scale. The 1. finger (index) plays every note that is on that fret. The index changes strings, but stays on the same fret. The 2. finger does the same, etc. Keep the hand in place and do not cross fret lines with other fingers.

Concentrate on learning the PATTERN, not the notes or intervals. You want your fingers to memorize a pattern of moving up and down the strings, so that you can eventually play without thinking.
